

The Commission's handling of the complainant's correspondence about safety policies for 'Powered Two-Wheelers' ('PTW')

Allegation(s)

- 1) The Commission's Directorate-General for Mobility and Transport (DG MOVE) wrongly decided to discontinue correspondence with the complainant.
- 2) DG MOVE failed properly to deal with the complainant's request for access to documents relating to:
 - (a) the " *Periodic Technical Inspections* " (the 'PTI survey');
 - (b) the impact assessment on " *Type Approval* " conducted by the Directorate-General for Enterprise and Industry;
 - (c) the budget allocated by the Commission to " *Road Safety* "; and
 - (d) the " *SAFERIDER* " programme.

Claim(s)

- 1) DG MOVE should properly address the technical points and questions raised in the complainant's e-mail of 13 February 2011.
- 2) DG MOVE should give the complainant access to the requested documents.
