

Decision of the European Ombudsman on complaint 233/2000/GG against the European Commission

Case 233/2000/GG - Opened on <math>22/02/2000 - Decision on 05/12/2000

Strasbourg, 5 December 2000 Dear Dr M., On 14 February 2000 you made a complaint to the European Ombudsman against the European Commission concerning Leonardo Project INTEQUAL (Contract number: D/95/1/217/III.2.a/FPI; Project number: 3892). In your complaint you claimed that the Commission had failed to provide you with a proper and complete breakdown of the payment it had made to you. On 29 November 2000, you informed me that the Commission had made an additional payment to you. In a further letter sent via e-mail on 5 December 2000, you informed me that you had received a letter from the Commission that included the final balance calculation with a complete breakdown of costs. You added that you were satisfied with the result and thanked me for my support in achieving the latter.
