



## Failure of the Commission to comply with the rules in the approval of active substances and the setting of maximum residue levels

Case opened

**Case** 2000/2015/ANA - **Opened on** 16/03/2016 - **Decision on** 22/03/2018 - **Institution concerned** European Commission ( No maladministration found ) |

Allegation(s)

The Commission's practice of setting the maximum residue levels for plant protection products only after the approval of the active substance is contrary to the relevant applicable legislation.

Claim(s)

The Commission should

- 1) cease the practice of setting the maximum residue levels of plant protection products only after the approval of the active substance;
- 2) set the maximum residue levels for plant protection products for which an EFSA opinion exists.
