Dear Sir/Madam,

With a letter from 25 September 2018, the European Ombudsman asked the Parliamentary Ombudsman of Iceland if Iceland had in place a complaint mechanism within the meaning of Article 74(3) of Regulation 1303/2013, whether that complaint mechanism can be considered „effective“ and whether the ombudsman had received any complaints related to ESI Funds or the adequacy of the complaint mechanisms in place.

In short, I can confirm that Regulation 1303/2013 does not apply in Iceland, as it falls outside the scope of the EEA Agreement. We have therefore not had any complaints or other cases concerning the issues raised in the letter and cannot share any relevant information on the matter.
