

Statistical information requested under OI/4/2023/MIK

The Digital Markets Act - 2020/0374(COD):

All non-public documents requested for the first time were disclosed at confirmatory level following a single request, with reference 2022-239, which was subject to 253/2023/MIK.

As Parliament noted during the inquiry under 253/2023/MIK, the applicant under 2022-239, who had been provided with the wrong (already public) document at initial level, initiated a campaign which led to the submission of 65 similar applications before receiving all identified documents at confirmatory level.

(duration of procedure: 1 working day at initial, 39 working days at confirmatory level)

The Revision of the Emissions Trading Scheme Directive - 2021/211(COD):

There were three initial (2022-0575; 2022-0848; 2022-1507) and no confirmatory applications concerning non-public documents. The procedures led to full access being granted after 7, 9 and 28 working days, respectively, and concerned compromise amendments voted in committee (first two requests) as well as trilogue documents (third request).

(mean/ median duration of procedure: 14.6/ 9 working days)

The Minimum Wage Directive - 2020/0310(COD):

There were two initial (2022-1056; 2023-0132) and no confirmatory applications regarding non-public documents. The procedures led to full access to trilogue documents and the refusal of access to a legal opinion, respectively.

(duration of procedure: 24 working days for both cases)
