2. Refers, with regard to the fulfilment of the conditions for appointment as Members of the Court of Auditors by the five Members whose reappointment is proposed, to its previous opinions and hereby confirms them;
3. Notes that on the basis of his previous experience, Mr Hebette fulfils the conditions for appointment to this office;
4. Decides, together with the Council, to declare that the five Members of the Court of Auditors named above are reappointed and that Mr Hebette is appointed accordingly;
5. Pays tribute to the work done during his term of office by Mr Paul Gaudy in the fields of the European Social Fund, the EAGGF (Guidance Section), fisheries, loans and credits and the ECSC;
6. Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the Council and the Court of Auditors and, for information, to the other institutions.

RESOLUTION

on the deliberations of the Committee on Petitions during the first six months of 1987

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Rule 129 (4) and (5) of the Rules of Procedure,
- having regard to its decision of 21 January 1987 to create a separate Committee on Petitions ⁽¹⁾,
- having regard to the report of the Committee on Petitions (Doc. A2-152/87;

1. Takes note of the Committee on Petitions' report on its activities, during the first six months of 1987 and of the outcome of its deliberations (Annex I);
2. Authorizes the Committee on Petitions to continue its deliberations on ways of improving the petitions procedure and to make suitable proposals in due course;
3. Instructs its President to forward this resolution and the committee's report to the Commission, Council, ombudsmen and petitions committees of the Member States.
